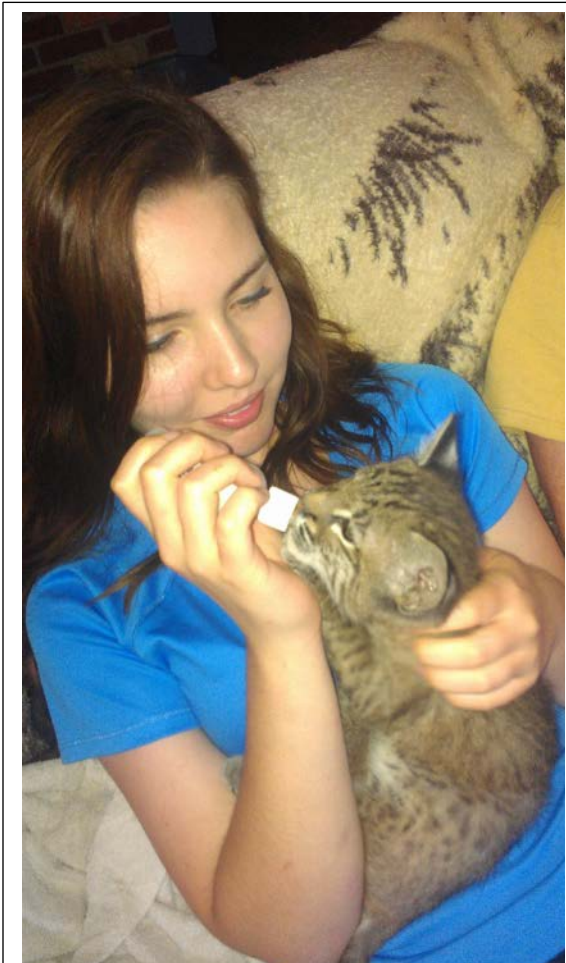




The FCF Wild/Exotic Feline Husbandry Course developed in 1999 has been continuously updated to keep this course relevant and accurate.
